The first known Australian cookbook published in 1864 was shown at an exhibition of historic Australian cookbooks revealing the tastes of the country's pioneers. Mrs Rawson's recipes describe the delights of a baked bandicoot, a hearty parrot stew or a succulent black swan cygnet, though pride of place goes to "slippery bob" - battered kangaroo brains deep-fried in emu fat. The book also provided tips for hosting the ideal dinner party, advising never more than 12 guests so that "the conversation might be constantly general" and adds the women should be "pleasant without too much coquetry." Mrs Rawson was also more than a century ahead of her time in extolling the virtues of "bush tucker" eaten by Aborigines, an area that modern Australian chefs have only recently begun to explore. "I am beholden to the blacks for nearly all my knowledge of the edible ground game," she writes, going on to praise the taste of witchetty grubs -- "there is nothing nasty or disgusting in these soft white morsels, any more so than an oyster."
